Phil's practice includes serving as trial counsel in complex multi-district or multi-jurisdiction litigation.

He has also arbitrated disputes under the rules of the American Arbitration Association, the CPR Institute for Dispute Resolution and the International Chamber of Commerce in Paris, France.

Prior to his private sector work, Phil was a law clerk to the Honorable Alice M. Batchelder, U.S. Court of Appeals for the Sixth Circuit. He also worked for three years in the Wisconsin legislature, serving ultimately as the chief of staff to Senator Lynn Adelman, who now serves on the U.S. District Court, Eastern District of Wisconsin in Milwaukee.

Phil teaches an advanced course on Expert Witnesses and Scientific Evidence at Case Western Reserve University's School of Law. Additionally, he has served as a faculty member at the Litigation Academy of the U.S. District Court for the District of Rhode Island, a skills-based program focused on developing courtroom techniques for direct and cross-examination of expert witnesses.

Phil serves as a public member of the Sixth Circuit Advisory Committee on Rules, a role to which he was appointed by then-Chief Judge Danny Boggs of the Sixth Circuit. In 2012 Phil was named chair of the committee. He is also a life member of the judicial Conference of the Sixth Circuit.
